I would like to update you on attendance and emphasise the importance of excellent attendance and punctuality at St John's. Congratulations to our children and parents/carers as the vast majority of our pupils have excellent attendance above 97%, which means that they can benefit fully from their learning in school. I would, of course, like all our students to have excellent attendance, but realise that for some students this is not the case.

Our aim is for all students to have attendance as close to 100% as possible. If a child is not here every day, on time, their learning suffers. If they arrive late they disturb the learning of others.

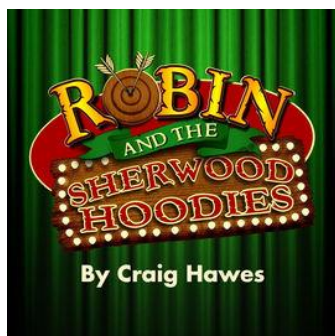
