
Our school is currently running at 94.3% attendance which is below our target of 97%, with your support this will improve.

Welcome back to another busy term.

As many of you will be aware from the national news, schools are currently facing growing financial pressures due to budget cuts and increasing costs. This **could** mean schools face choices of increased class sizes, loss of teaching and support staff, fewer resources and a lack of out of school activities. None of which are positive.

At The Keys Federation Academy Trust we are always looking to ensure our schools provide the very best education possible for the children in our care whilst continuing to be financially sound.

We are committed to ensuring our children continue to receive a 'whole education' with exciting opportunities to enhance their learning and develop each individual child. We nurture their talents and skills through our unique approach to Music, Sport and Art with our Academy specialists.

As you know, from September 2017, we have introduced a £1 per week payment for after-school activities, which assists with the increased staffing costs and any additional resources needed for these extra-curricular clubs. We are grateful for your support with this as we, and you too, clearly value our staff's commitment to providing a range of additional activities for your children.

We are extremely conscious of the economic climate and the effect on our families and will always endeavour to keep any additional costs, i.e. trips and visits to an absolute minimum.

We are also investigating the option of Parent Pay within our Trust, which will make it easier for you to make, and keep track of, payments to school and Play Pals. Look out for more information on this in the near future.
